Who is eligible:

PhD-students and young Postdocs (PhD defense from 1. January 2017 onwards or < 35 years old), from countries in the Danube River Basin and/or IAD-members

- pdf-file with abstract; the concrete conference session if applicable; note if it is submitted as an oral and/or poster presentation
- **short** statements in email text about the current carrier status as young researcher (indicate year of PhD work or PostDoc & research framework, how it is linked to past or ongoing PhD grants from universities or other grants and/or research projects, provide websites if available)

Financial support: maximum 400 € per person (travel expenses & conference fee)

Applications are assessed against the following criteria:

Scientific soundness of conference contribution & Early career status of young scientist
