PhD-students and young Postdocs (PhD defense from 1. January 2019 onwards or < 35 years old), from countries in the Danube River Basin and/or IAD-members

- **short** statement in email text about the current carrier status as young researcher (indicate year of PhD work or PostDoc & research framework, how your current position is funded by past or ongoing PhD grants from universities or other grants and/or research projects, provide websites if available).

Scientific soundness of conference contribution & Early career status of young scientist
